

St Joseph's Primary School Uniform Policy



Please be mindful that the St Joseph's School Uniform policy is non-negotiable.

Parents are asked to positively encourage the correct wearing of uniform at all times.

All students are expected to be neat in appearance whilst at school. It is expected that students will wear the full school uniform each day (please label all uniform items clearly). Teachers will inform parents of sports days at the commencement of each term. Sports uniform should only be worn for sports days or for special sporting events (carnivals).

SHOES

Please ensure that students abide by the school policy regarding shoes. Black shoes only are acceptable with the school day uniform. Shoes should not have coloured labels and logos, coloured markings etc — school shoes are simply black.



HATS

Our school has a "No hat - No play" rule as part of our SunSmart Policy. Students are only permitted to wear a school hat through the day and classes do not have hats for borrowing. St Joseph's hats are ONLY sold in the school uniform shop.

WINTER

Boys: Long grey trousers or royal blue tracksuit with blue school shirt, grey socks and black shoes. Unisex St Joseph's pullover or unisex St Joseph's jacket.

Girls: Royal blue track suit or royal blue opaque tights with summer uniform, white socks and black shoes. Unisex St Joseph's pullover or unisex St Joseph's jacket.



JEWELLERY

Wearing of jewellery should be kept to a minimum for both safety and security reasons.

In relation to jewellery at school, the following is acceptable:

- watch
- signet ring
- studs or sleepers – one small sized, plain gold or silver pair in lower ear lobe only
- chain with crucifix or religious medal
- Plastic, leather, ceramic etc. necklaces and chains are not permitted.

HAIR

Hair should be neat and tidy and appropriately cut. Extremes in style (Mullets, Tracks, shaved designs and skin fades) cut or colour are **unacceptable**. This will be at the discretion of the Principal.

Hair ribbons and ties should be in school colours or plain black or brown only.

All students with collar length hair must have it tied up and back **at all times** with a ribbon or band.

NAIL POLISH

Nail polish is not an acceptable part of the St Joseph's uniform and must be removed before students attend school.

POLICY REVIEW

The policy will be reviewed by the St Joseph's Catholic Primary School Board not less frequently than once every three years.
